

In Fiscal Year 2014-2015 when the Florida Legislature invested 100%, Lake Countybased arts and cultural nonprofits generated

\$380,000 back to LOCAL government treasury; \$635,000 back to STATE government treasury for a total of \$1,015,000 returned to government treasuries.
